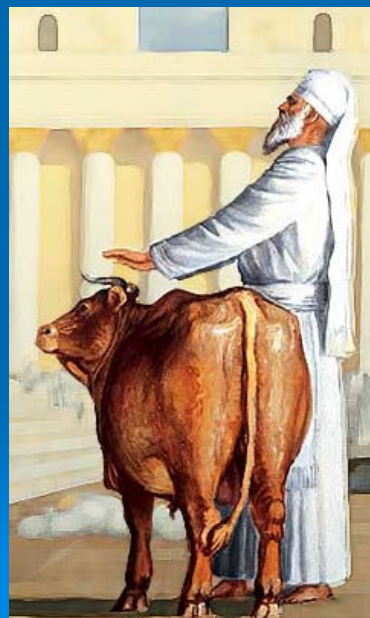
1 Peter 2: 4

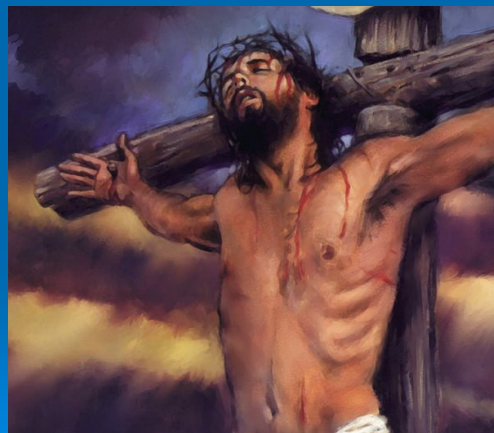

Our Ransom is Paid

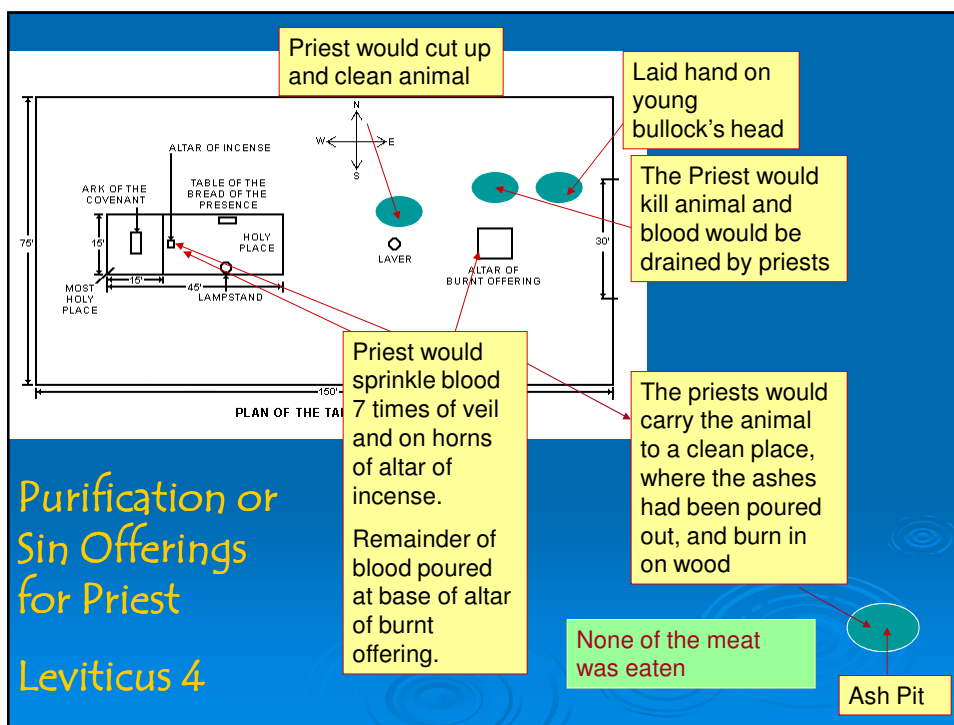
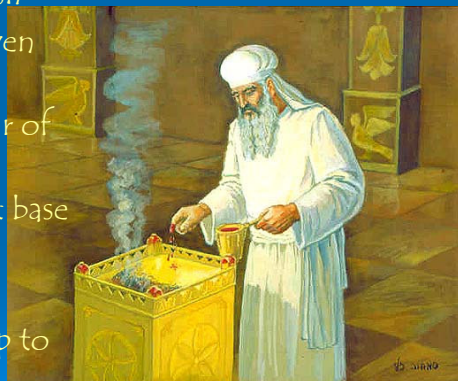

Sin Offerings – 4 Categories

➤ The Priest

- Young bullock without blemish
- Blood sprinkled before veil seven times
- Blood rubbed on horns of altar of incense
- Remainder of blood poured at base of altar of burnt offering
- Kidney, Fat, Liver burned
- Remainder taken outside camp to ash pit and burned on wood



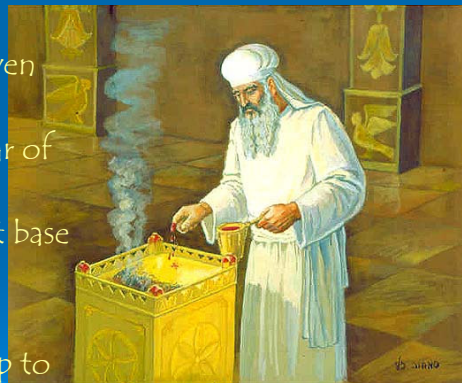
Congregational Sin Offerings Required – Number 28-28

- New Moons
- Each day of Feast of Unleavened Bread
- Day of Feast of Weeks
- First day of the seventh month
- Day of Atonement
- Each day of Feast of Tabernacles
- Any time congregation was guilty of transgression in omitting a specific commandment

Sin Offerings – 4 Categories

➤ The Whole Congregation

- Young Bullock
- Blood sprinkled before veil seven times
- Blood rubbed on horns of altar of incense
- Remainder of blood poured at base of altar of burnt offering
- Kidney, Fat, Liver burned
- Remainder taken outside camp to ash pit and burned on wood



Leaders would cut up and clean animal removing fat, kidneys and liver to be burned

Tribal leaders laid hand on young bullock's head

The tribal leaders would kill animal and blood would be drained by priests

Priest would sprinkle blood 7 times of veil and on horns of altar of incense.

The priest would carry the animal to a clean place, where the ashes had been poured out, and burn in on wood

None of the meat was eaten

Purification or Sin Offerings for Whole Congregation

Leviticus 4

Sin Offerings – 4 Categories

- **The Ruler (tribal elders)**
 - Male goat without blemish
 - Blood rubbed on horns of altar of burnt offering
 - Remainder of blood poured at base of altar of burnt offering
 - Kidney, Fat, Liver burned
 - Remainder eaten by Priest (6:26, 29 and 10:17)
 - Any male member of the priest's family could eat

Purification or Sin Offerings for Tribal Rulers

Leviticus 4

The ruler would cut up and clean animal removing the fat, kidneys and liver for burning

The ruler laid hand on he-goat's head

The ruler would kill animal and blood would be drained by priests

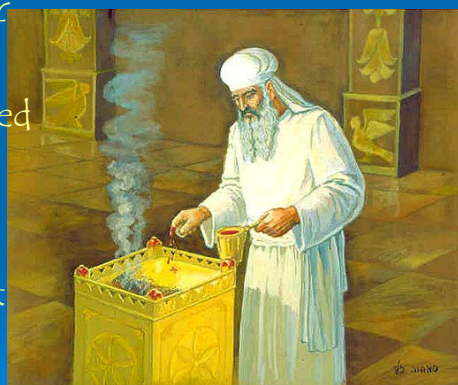
Priest would rub some of the blood on the horns of the altar. Remainder of blood poured at the base of the altar of burnt offering.

The priest would eat the animal of the sacrifice of the rulers and common people. Any male member of a priests family could eat the meat.

Sin Offerings – 4 Categories

➤ Common People

- Female goat or lamb
- Blood rubbed on horns of altar of burnt offering
- Remainder of blood poured at base of altar of burnt offering
- Kidney, Fat, Liver burned
- Remainder eaten by Priest (6:26, 29 and 10:17)
- Any male member of the priest's family could eat



Reasons for Sin Offering for Commoner Leviticus 5:1-6

- Heard an oath made, and the situation arose where a witness to that oath were needed, and he did not speak up, he would be guilty
- Touched something that was unclean and thus unwittingly defiled himself, upon learning of it, he was to offer a female goat or lamb
- Careless in his speech and swore an oath and then sinned in regard to something he had sworn the oath was about, when he learned it, he was to offer a sin offering

PLAN OF THE TABERNACLE

The commoner would cut up and clean animal removing the fat, kidneys and liver for burning

The commoner laid hand on female goat or lambs head

The commoner would kill animal and blood would be drained by priests

A poor commoner could bring two turtle doves or two pigeons, or if poorer still – two to three quarts of flour

Priest would rub some of the blood on the horns of the altar.

Remainder of blood poured at the base of the altar of burnt offering.

The priest would eat the animal of the sacrifice of the rulers and common people.

Leviticus 4

Restitution or Guilt Offerings – 3 Reasons Given

Leviticus 5:14 – 6:7

- ◊ If a man sinned in not offering God what was commanded
- ◊ Depriving of God of what was owed to Him in some way not involved in offerings.
- ◊ Wrongfully keeping a deposit given one by his neighbor, or wrongfully seizing a possession.

Restitution Is Required – Number 5:5-10

- ◊ Sins must be confessed
- ◊ Full restitution for guilt must be made
- ◊ Twenty percent above value must be given to the victim
- ◊ Restitution to a dead man must be given to his kin
- ◊ If no kin, it must be given to the Lord and property of priests
